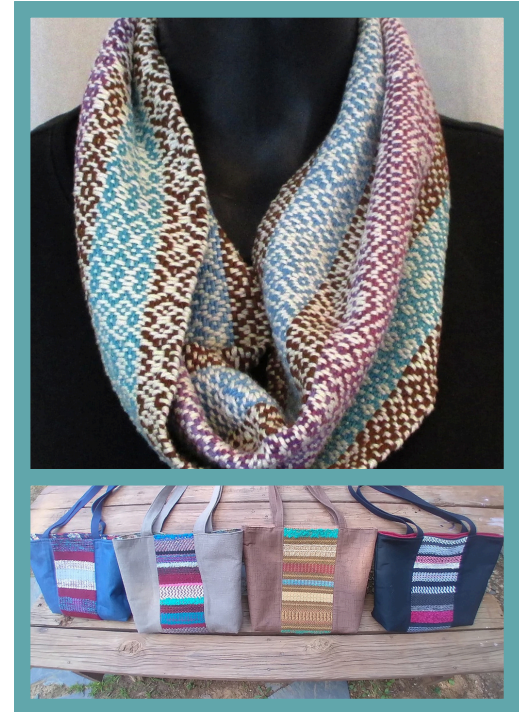

- Begin with a naked loom, and learn to dress the loom for weaving.
- Weave a complete project, with some finishing at home.
- Projects and techniques vary: scarves, placemats, tote bags, towels, coasters and runners.
- Contact Patricia for the current project.
- Unique offering uses three types of looms: 4 or 8-shaft, or rigid heddle.
- Loom preference will be selected by order of class registration.
- Shaft looms available for rental, rent-to-own, or sale after class, if desired.
- No experience required.
- Adults and teens welcome.
- Small class size; limit of 12 students.
